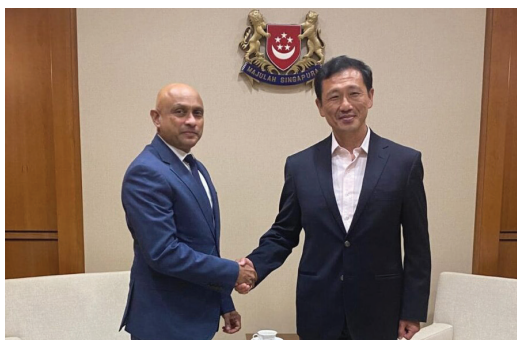


Philippine Culture Celebrated Through Music and Dance in Singapore
